
Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculan










What does your child need to bring and do?

- ✓ Book bag
- Reading book with home link book
- ✓ Wear <u>named</u> school uniform
- ✓ Wear suitable clothing for outdoor play
- ✓ Wear shoes that he/she can take on and off independently (velcro shoes)
- ✓ PE kit comes to school on Monday and goes home Friday (or wear on PE day)
- ✓ Named water bottle
