



Dear Parents/Carers

COVID-19 Symptoms and Tests

As cases are rising, we want to remind you of what needs to be done if you or your child has any of the main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19):

A high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature).

A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual).

A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If you or your child has any of these symptoms, get a PCR test (test that is sent to a lab) to check if you have coronavirus and stay at home until you get your result.

Please do not do a Lateral Flow Test under these circumstances as it will not be acceptable as proof of a negative test. Thank you and let's keep our community safe.
