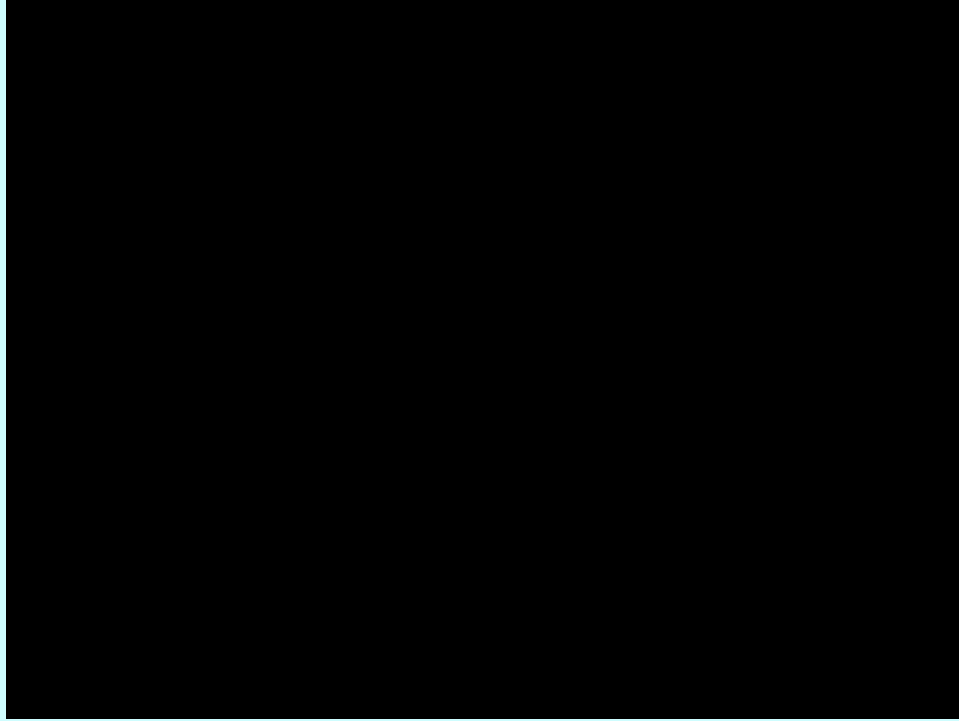

Expectations

We would really appreciate your support, by:

Maths and Literacy Sets

What does Year 6 look like?

Key stage 2

The key stage 2 tests are timetabled from Monday 9 May to Thursday 12 May 2022.

Monday 9 May 2022	English grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2
Tuesday 10 May 2022	English reading
Wednesday 11 May 2022	Mathematics papers 1 and 2
Thursday 12 May 2022	Mathematics paper 3

The SATS dates for next year will be Monday 8th May to Thursday 11th May 2023.

The order is likely to be the same as this year.

SATS Preparation

Although Year 6 is the year of KS2 end-of-key-stage assessments, preparation is introduced subtly.

Baseline assessments in October, and Mock SATS in February, alongside end-of-term assessments, give teachers a good indication of children's progress, and also areas of the curriculum that require further teaching.

Daily afternoon interventions, as well as after school booster sessions, will help children make accelerated progress.

We also establish throughout the year if your child requires any access arrangements to complete the tests (a reader, prompter, scribe, transcribe, extra time). This will be communicated to parents if relevant.
