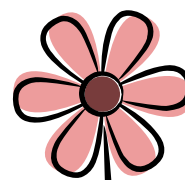




Calcot Infant Leaver's Newsletter July 2026

"I liked when it was World Book Day because we can dress up as any characters from a book." - Brooke 2RT

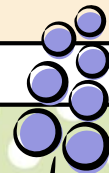
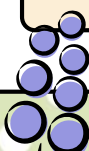
A Special Goodbye from Infant School

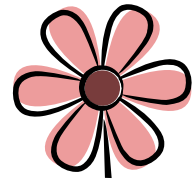
